	<p>1. Introductions and Welcomes Joanna welcomed everyone to the meeting.</p> <p>Apologies from Justin Hackney, Richard Eccles, Sheridan Dodsworth and John Waters.</p> <p>2. Matters Arising</p> <p>Joanna attended Bournemouth and fed back that it was interesting but it was a long journey</p> <p>Lisa Loy has been invited to healthy lifestyles working group.</p> <p>Meeting with David Culy about LSAB they would be happy to have LDP present on work they do. Action: Meeting required between Voiceability and David Culy to Plan this.</p>

Updates from Learning Disability Partnership</p> <p>Lorraine Abbott presented update from LDP.</p> <p>Voices for all - Opportunities for all 32 attendees at voices for all meeting in December. 16 people with LD. Attendees from Gainsborough and Spilsby as well as Lincoln. Next meeting in Spilsby. John Waters led sessions around what people enjoy and what they are good at and how these can be turned into community support/community activities. Community small sparks project. Lorraine enjoyed the meeting and enjoyed</p>



speaking to people that liked the same things. She said it's surprising how different people like the same things.

Community Supported Living

Updated on work LDP have done regarding the CSL services.

Around 50 people engaged with over 7/8 different sites in Lincolnshire.

People had a mix of 24 hour support and some with few hours of support.

Joanna Tubb wondered if they felt different levels of safety depending on service type ie 24/7 or floating support

Identified people received various different levels of support, different across areas due to past circumstances.



CQC & Healthwatch

Linkage and James Bell with support from Voiceability.

People with LD said how they wanted to be involved in inspections.

Inspector went away with changes he was going to make based on what people said and report will be sent back to Voiceability.

John asked if CQC had questioned about how they ask carers of people with LD and their views about providers.

Aware that CQC used to contact parents but doesn't seem to happen anymore –**Action: Marie will look into this.**



Healthy lifestyles Working Group

Meeting with LPFT and CCG's to see how can work together in the best way.

Lorraine advised she is going to be updating a video on annual health checks with LPFT. **Action: Lisa would like contact of people that are working on this.**



Staying safe working group

Kerry attended external training from Google around internet citizens and learnt about keeping people safe, fake news, manipulation etc. Kerry is putting this together with existing training package on keeping people safe.

Connect to support

Self-advocates- Amy and Craig gave feedback to LCC on Connect to Support.



Help for hidden disabilities

Sunflower lanyard available from supermarkets, Lincolnshire tourism board, castle, cathedral. Not just LD.

National programme – train station and airports. Some places give them out, some places loan them while using the venue.

Can purchase multiples.

Joanna wondered who owns the programme. – and if there is information that can be sent to the commercial team. **Action: Find information and look to see if needs to go on LCC website.**



4. Communications and Involving Carers

Spoke about meetings between LCC comms team, Voiceability and Lincs Parent Carer Forum.

Discussion over who would own social media agreed LCC would need to own group.

Social media can create a range of connections.

Lorraine advised how we need to be aware some people with LD are also carers.

Small at moment, spoken about it. Need to go for it now, do something.

People that want to help, but need to set it up for them to then take it further.

LA there will be people that can and want to help the running of the group. **Action: LCC speak again with comms team. Would be starting small.**

Joanna informed board of short breaks work looking at carers groups online about sharing the care – creating networks online.





Forums about different areas are common would be good to have one for LD.




5. Update on Transforming Care

	<p>6. Learning Disability and Autism Training to become mandatory for all social care and health care staff</p> <p>Good news update.</p> <p>Experts by experience have been involved in this. Lisa advised this needs to be incorporated within our commissioned services. Joanna has shared this with LCC staff.</p>
	<p>7. Other Commissioning Strategies</p> <p>Joanna gave brief updates on all commissioning priorities within the Specialist Adults Services Strategy.</p>
 	<p>8. AOB</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Lisa Loy from public health advised the board on work public health were starting on looking at the public health offer to specialist services. Some work around health checks and understanding differences in levels of health. Project brief to be signed off – planning work around and plan to work with LDP around the public health services e.g. Smoking cessation, sexual health etc. and if these services are accessible. PH deep dive into what's on offer. Lisa to attend next staying healthy working group. • John Gurney raised concerns carers have about level and difficulty on recruiting staff into caring and support staff and asked if LCC have plans for outcome of election and what it will mean for care staff. Joanna informed the board that there is contingency work being done around brexit and all providers have contingency plans in place. The general difficulties in recruiting care staff, is a
